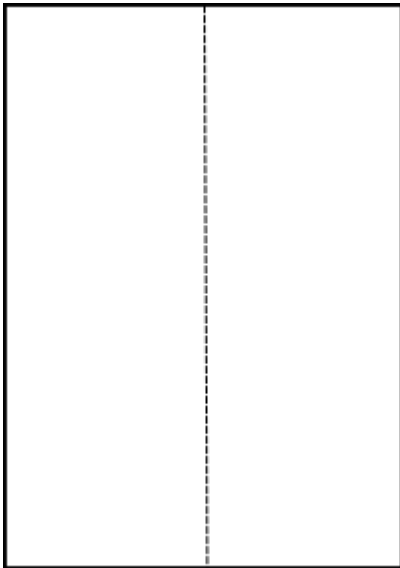
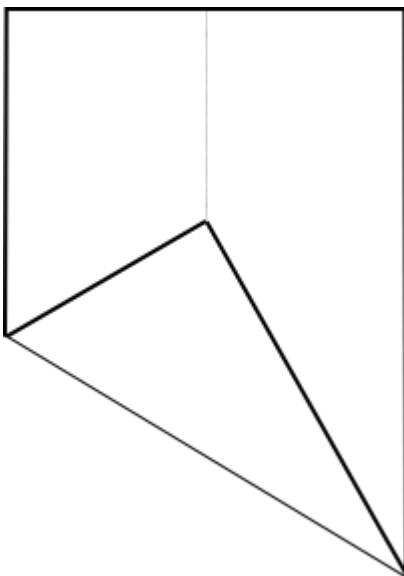


Take a piece of paper.
